<u>PE and uniform reminders!</u>

A few reminders ahead of the new school year!

-Children should wear black shoes- not boots.

-Jewellery should not be worn other than small stud type earrings. If there are plans to get ears pierced, please note that the summer holidays are a good opportunity as **earrings need to be removed** for all PE sessions.

-Nail varnish should not be worn.

-Long hair should be tied back. Headlice is very frustrating for everyone, if hair is tied back, it can help to minimise transmission.

-Water bottles need to be non-spill and not made of glass. There has been a number of issues with water bottles and many are too large and inappropriate for the classroom. We are asking that children only use school water bottles from September. These can be purchased for £2.00 from the school office.
