This half term, our eco committee have been split into smaller groups to undertake an audit of our schools eco performance. They have been checking our biodiversity, waste, litter, energy usage and more. These audits will inform our action plan as we move forward in our application for another Eco Schools Green Flag award.

Support the Christmas Shoe Box Appeal

The shoebox appeal brings joy and hope each year to many thousands of people of all ages. These gifts have brought smiles to children and adults living in poverty in Eastern Europe, Africa, Asia, Latin America and even the UK. Here's what you need to do to prepare your shoebox:

- Gift wrap the box and lid separately so the lid can be lifted off, please don't wrap individual items, use an elastic band to keep the box 1.
- Choose the age and gender of the person you want to receive your shoebox and fill the box with suitable items. Shoeboxes are sent to all ages from babies to elderly people.
- Label the box with who it is for e.g. Girl aged 3-5 years, Boy aged 9-11 years, Adult Female aged 60+ years.

Ideas for what to include:

Stationery / school supplies:

Pens, pencils, crayons, eraser, sharpener, notebooks, colouring books, maths set, if sending scissors to children, please ensure they are round ended safety type.

Toothbrush, toothpaste, soap, flannel or sponge, comb, hair bobbles, roll on deodorant, No sprays, medicines, vitamins, tablets.

Toys:

Small toys, cuddly toys, balls, skipping rope, games, small jigsaws etc. No guns or war toys.

Socks, T-shirts, hats, scarves, gloves, underwear, Babygro for little ones.

Practical Items:

Plastic bowl, cup, cutlery.

For teens and adults: a small sewing kit, string, safety pins, a wind up torch or plasters. No matches.

Greetings:

You could send a card with a cheerful picture or encouraging message, please don't include your personal contact details.

Please make sure sweets have a long use-by date, no chocolates.

The deadline to drop off a box at Brabin's School is Friday 29th November 2024. Please note that we cannot deliver boxes after this date.

It costs £2 to collect, store, transport and distribute each shoebox. Please give the office £2 when you drop off the box.
