Penalty Fine Information

As you are aware, new legislation regarding attendance was put into place by the government in August 2024.

All holidays will be unauthorised, and for periods of over 5 days of unauthorised absence, this will result in a penalty fine. Please be aware that this will also be the case if 5 days is exceeded over the course of the school year and not just a single absence. For example, 4 days in the autumn term and then a 2-day unauthorised absence in the summer term will trigger a penalty fine.
